The results of the survey are summarized in the following section:

1. Report Questions – patients were asked about specific experiences or were asked for specific information.

Sample and Methodology

100 questionnaires were printed and were made readily available on the reception counter for patients to take part in August 2013.

The questionnaires were also actively offered to patients attending the surgery, either to be completed whilst in the practice or taken away and returned at a later date. The receptionists explained briefly what the questionnaire was about and answering any questions patients may have.

67 questionnaires were returned completed and these were then analysed in-house.

The Online Access Patient survey is designed for adults at least 16 years of age.
