2. Summary Care Record

A Summary Care Record is an electronic record which contains information about the medicines you take, allergies you suffer from and bad reactions to medicines you have had. Having this information stored in one place makes it easier for healthcare staff to treat you in an emergency or when your GP Practice is closed.

Patients are automatically opted in unless they decide to opt out. If you want to opt out of the Summary Care Record, please inform one of the receptionists.

3. Care.Data Programme

Patients would have received information by post regarding the Care.Data Programme by now. Please read the information carefully. Patients will be automatically opted in unless they decide to opt out. If you wish to opt out of the Care.Data Programme, please kindly inform one of the receptionists.
