

General Data Protection Regulation

What's the GDPR all about?

The general data protection regulation is a new document which helps your doctor's surgery keep the information about you safe.

People who look after your information are called data controllers and the people who use your data are called data processors.

You can ask to see the information we hold about you at any time and if you are under 16 but over 12, you may be able to do this yourself.

Consent means you allow us to use your information for the purpose of your care and parental consent is required if you are under 16. Don't worry we won't share your information if you don't want to us to.
